9:15 am	<p>Church School</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Adult Ministry Sessions (<i>See Curriculum Guide</i>)</li> <li>- Teens start at 9:30. (<i>Enter the Youth Room on the left side of the hall, down toward Fellowship Hall.</i>)</li> <li>- Adolescents/Teens/Confirmands</li> <li>- School Aged</li> <li>- Preschool</li> <li>- Nursery (<i>Enter the Nursery off the Rotunda</i>)</li> </ul>
10:30 am	<p>Worship begins in the Sanctuary. Youth attend with adults and may stay or leave the sanctuary during the service to attend:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Children's church.</b> Announced by Pastor Wilson or Pastor Cynthia. Otherwise, ask the adult leading the children from the sanctuary.</li> <li>- <b>Children's choir.</b> Children leave the sanctuary after the Children's Message and follow adult leader's to the choir room behind the choir loft in the sanctuary. After practice the choir leader adults take the children to the classrooms in the Preschool wing for stories and crafts</li> <li>- <b>Cherub choir.</b> Children leave the sanctuary after the Children's Message and follow adult leader's to the chapel. After practice the choir leader adults take the children to the classrooms in the Preschool wing for stories and crafts</li> <li>- <b>Teens</b> may leave the sanctuary after the Children's Message and join the session in the Youth Room.</li> </ul> <p>Adults please meet school aged children after worship in their respective rooms noted above. Thank you.</p>
